Emergency Advice

Go to the emergency department with your letter if:

- You are soaking 2 Maxi pads per hour for more than 2 hours in a row
- You pass clots the size of a small lemon or larger
- You have severe cramps and the pain tablets do not help

Seek advice if:

- You are worried and not sure if you need to go to hospital
- You vomit within 1 hour of taking Step 1 (Mifepristone)
- If you accidentally swallow Step 2 GyMiso (Misoprostol) before the 30 minutes is up
- It has been 24 hours since taking Step 2 GyMiso (Misoprostol) and you:
 - Still have chills, fever, dizziness, diarrhoea or vomiting
 - Still feel unwell or are in a lot of pain
 - Have had less bleeding than expected

Remember, on the day you take Step 2 GyMiso (Misoprostol) it is normal to:

- Have pain, cramping and heavy bleeding
- Pass clots
- Pass the pregnancy tissue
- Have chills, fever, diarrhoea, dizziness, feel sick or vomit (this should pass)
